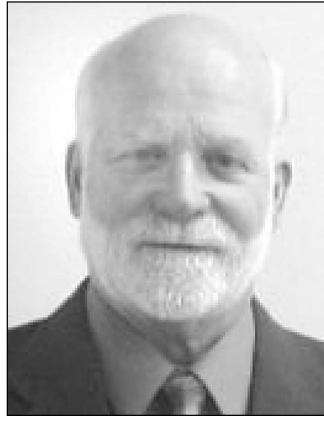

A Busy Spring for the Chamber


This spring myself and the Chamber's WFD coordinator, Paula Frings, made a CEO's in the Schools, WFD presentation to the Cloquet Chamber of Commerce. Cloquet would be the first NE MN Regional Chamber to replicate the Grand Rapids Area Chamber CEO Program. Winona, MN is already engaged in this project and is using material that we created with our WFD initiative. Plans are also being formed to roll this program out to more schools in NE MN, in Partnership with the Applied Learning

Institute. *We were also able to put together two special luncheons last month. One was with Governor Tim Pawlenty and the other was with MN Commissioner of Education, Alice Seagren. About 140 Chamber Members and guests attended these two events. *A two year grant from the Blandin Foundation to Depot Commons was also received to support an Itasca Area Branding Grant Manager to work with local businesses and organizations to identify opportunities to promote the new Brand and the Itasca Area. A Branding roll out forum is being planned for later in May. *Also an important recommendation from the Lessard Outdoor Heritage Council to allocate about \$40 Million dollars over the next two years to fund the Upper Mississippi Forest Conservation Easement Project. Additional funds committed bring the total to \$49 Million dollars, \$7 Million of which is a special grant from the Blandin Foundation. This Conservation Easement is intended to protect about 180,000 acres of working forest land from fragmentation and would guarantee

public access and a timber harvesting plan. Once the recommendation is made from the Lessard Outdoor Heritage Council, the legislature will make the final decision as to allocations. Other legislative challenges that we are working on include moving the Canisteo Mine Pit issue forward, opposing a bill that would restrict non-ferrous mining in Minnesota, the reconstruction of Highway 169 East, the reduction of Local Government Aid and the Post Labor Day School Start issue. *A couple of up-coming events that you will want to participate in are the annual Fishing Opener Community BBQ that is sponsored by the Chamber's Area Business Committee, the First Annual Grand Rapids Area Chamber Pokegama Lake Walleye Classic and the Chambers Annual Golf Outing and Fun Day. Watch your e-mails for dates and times and details. *Finally, we all need to remember to make sure that we are re-investing in our business community. Chamber Member Businesses are the Right Place for ALL of us to do business.

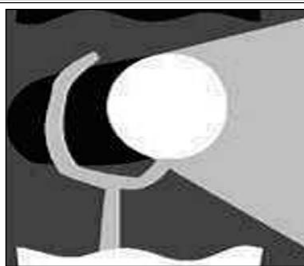

How I learned about the North Woods

As a child growing up in the Minneapolis suburbs I learned about the North Woods from my father. Born into a poor family in a small Nebraska town, my Dad's ticket to the big world came from the Navy ROTC. When the Korean War ended

he came to Minnesota to enroll in graduate school. A child of the prairie, my father's first experience with Minnesota's north country came when a University buddy invited him on a canoe trip. They drove up to Ely, down the Fernberg Trail to Lake One and on into Lake Insula. The experience changed him forever. Soon he had bought us a canoe and trips to the BWCA became a beloved family ritual. Around the campfire at night my Dad would read to us aloud from Sigurd Olson's Singing Wilderness and Listening Point.

Some years later he and my Mom bought 80 acres of woods and a modest "deer shack" in Cass County. Long a devoted birder and fisherman, my Dad now also became a tree lover. He got a forest management plan for his land. Every winter

he'd order seedlings. We'd plant them in the spring and bud cap them in the fall to protect them from the deer. Now his second growth forest of balsam and poplar is intermixed with young pine stands, the kind of trees that grew there before the "Big Cut." My Dad will turn 80 this year, but he's still planting trees. It's his gift to the future.

The good news for Minnesotans and especially for future Minnesotans is that there are a lot of people like my Dad taking care of their woods. Minnesota's Department of Natural Resources' Forest Stewardship Program has written management plans for over 10,000 family forest landowners, affecting 1.5 million acres. The Program is now in the process of updating its five-year plan, due to be unveiled in July. The plan provides

technical advice and long range planning guidance to forestland owners, including new information about emerging opportunities for family forest stewardship in the state. It endorses a goal set by Blandin Foundation's Vital Forests/Vital Communities Initiative to bring an additional million acres of family forest lands under stewardship by 2015. The plan revision process is being facilitated by Dovetail Partners with support from Blandin Foundation.

There will be opportunities for stakeholder review before the plan is finalized. Those with questions about the project can contact Andrew Arends, Cooperative Forest Management supervisor for the DNR Division of Forestry at 651/259-5261.

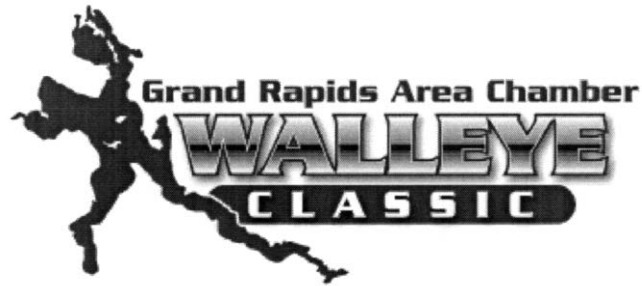
