

We both love the sport of golf and recently started to go camping with our family of 4. n 2019 we built a 28 site RV Park that is adjacent to our 9-hole golf course & provides full hook-ups for RV's including both 30 & 50 amp service at each site, water, & sewer. Our RV park also has a showerhouse with private, ¾ baths & a coin operated laundry facility. Since 2019 we have decided to expand our offerings at the RV Park to include an in-ground pool & hot tub that will be installed Spring of 2024.
